BDCB FINANCIAL AWARENESS ROADSHOW Wednesday, 19 Rejab 1445H corresponding to 31 January 2024M

1. Brunei Darussalam Central Bank (BDCB), in collaboration with the Royal Brunei Police Force (RBPF), Cyber Security Brunei (CSB), Baiduri Bank, Bank Islam Brunei Darussalam (BIBD), Standard Chartered Bank, and Perbadanan Tabung Amanah Islam Brunei (TAIB) organised a Financial Awareness Roadshow at Yayasan Haji Hassanal Bolkhiah Secondary School on Wednesday, 19 Rejab 1445H corresponding to 31 January 2024M.
2. During the roadshow, approximately 500 students from Years 7 to 11 from the school participated in interactive games and activities organised by the participating institutions.
3. The objective of the roadshow was to increase understanding of the Central Bank's roles and responsibilities, as well as provide participants with financial management skills and knowledge appropriate for their age.

Additionally, the RBPF also contributed by sharing information about their role as an enforcement agency to maintain law and order in the country while CSB educated students on the importance of online safety and the potential risks related to digital technology, and encouraged students to responsibly use the internet, especially social media.
5. The Central Bank also conducted a "Coin Exchange Programme" as part of the roadshow, providing an opportunity for teachers and students at the school to swap their coins for banknotes.
